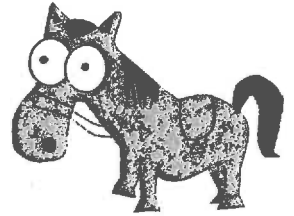
HORSES / PONIES

Junior and Senior (Senior = years 5 & 6 to 9 & 10)

PLEASE ENSURE THE HORSES THAT COME ARE SUITABLE, THIS WILL ENSURE WE CAN HAVE THEM AGAIN!

Horses and Ponies will be judged on leading and management and there will be some riding as well. Please ensure you have a competent adult to assist at all times.

The judge will question the child on the care of their pet e.g. gender, breed, who feeds it, what does it eat/how often and any special requirements.



LAMBS

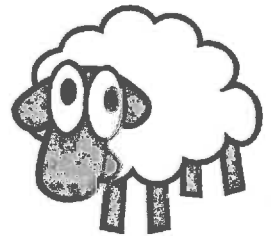
Junior and Senior (Senior = years 5 & 6 to 9 & 10)

Lambs must have been born after 1 June 2016.

Lambs are not to be washed or brushed and will be judged on leading, calling and care and attention.

The judge will question the child on the care of their pet e.g. gender, breed, who feeds it, what does it eat/how often and any special requirements.

Bring a bucket, and a lead or rope to secure your animal.



DOGS

Junior and Senior (Senior = years 5 & 6 to 9 & 10)

Dogs may be washed and groomed and will be judged on leading, calling and care and attention.

The judge will question the child on the care of their pet e.g. gender, breed, who feeds it, what does it eat/how often and any special requirements.

The dogs must be able to be tied up and have a container available for water.



OTHER PETS

Junior and Senior (Senior = years 5 & 6 to 9 & 10)

The judge will question the child on the care of their pet e.g. gender, breed, who feeds it, what does it eat/how often and any special requirements.

These animals must be in a secure container, cage or be able to be tied.



If children do not have pets please encourage them to enter the creative section.

Year 9 & 10 children that do not have pets will be involved as stewards and BBQ running.
There will be a BBQ running throughout Pet Day.

CREATIVE CREATIONS

Junior and Senior (Senior = years 5 & 6 to 9 & 10)

1 entry per child for each section.

Decorated Cupcakes

Cupcakes will not be tested for taste, only for presentation and skill.



Sand Saucer

Maximum size 16cm diam. Thoroughly cover saucer with sand and plant material only.

Vegetable and/or fruit novelty

i.e. making an animal using raw vegetables or fruit.



Scenic Tray

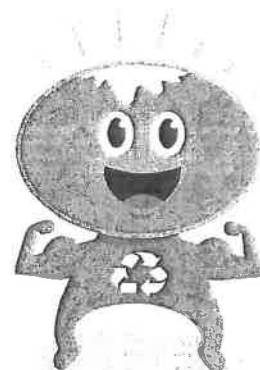
i.e. miniature garden, farm etc

Maximum size, oven dish - no cardboard boxes!

Recycled Creation

using anything recyclable!! -

(Sellotape, glue, etc. allowed for holding together)



Names will be written on card and turned upside down so that judging is anonymous.

Please encourage your child to start researching for ideas and start planning for this event. This is to be the child's work and will be judged according to age and ability.

Animal judging will run with the dogs, horses and lambs and other pets all happening concurrently. We need to know beforehand though.

Creation judging will be done in the gym. The creations are not to be collected until after 2:30pm so everyone can enjoy looking, PLEASE leave rosettes until your creation is collected.

Catlins Area School Pet Day Judging Guidelines

Ponies	Child Handler	Pony is able to be handled by child Will have obstacle course
	Child Effort	Pony is groomed and looked after by child
	Riding	There will be classing and games
Lambs	Leading	Lamb able to walk beside child Lamb able to stand as required
	Child Effort	Lamb is clean, feet, in good condition and knows what lamb is fed and how often
	Child Handler	Involves calling with steward holding lamb
Dogs	Leading	Dog able to walk beside child Dog able to stand as required Dog follows through obstacle course with no hesitation
	Child Effort	Dog is clean, feet, tail, been washed & brushed
	Child Handler	Involves calling with steward holding dog
Other Pet	Child Effort	Child knows about breed of animal, what animal gets fed, age of animal, breed, etc
	Child Handler	Child can handle animal (if suitable or can discuss handling)



Creative Categories

Judged on age and ability of child.
