To support our PB4L journey, our school has also implemented the Zones of Regulation® framework into our teaching and learning programmes across the school.

The Zones is an approach used to teach emotional self-regulation by categorising all the different ways we can feel and the states of alertness we experience into four concrete coloured zones.

It provides strategies to teach students to become more aware of and independent in being able to control their emotions and impulses, manage their sensory needs, and improve their ability to problem solve conflicts.

All of the zones are natural to experience, however, The Zones of Regulation framework focuses on teaching students how to recognise and manage their zone based on the environment, its demands, and the people around them.

We will be having a Zones of Regulation Parent Meeting to explain the Programme and its benefits on the same night as our Matariki celebration. While students are playing games in the gym at 5pm, the information meeting on Zones for parents will take place in the Hall.
