



The Catlins Area School - Pet Day 2022

Friday 11 November - from 10:30am

Pet Day will be held on the school grounds, following the signs for designated areas for pets. We welcome Little Hoiho, Tahakopa School and Community home schooled children who are joining us this year.

Students can enter ONE animal, plus a crafted animal if they choose. Judging of animals will be in **Little Hoiho + Junior** (Year 0-4) and **Senior** (Year 5-14) sections.

Students will be placed first, second or third in different pet categories, with judging being made on set criteria. Lapels, ribbons or rosettes will be awarded at the end of each category.

CRAFT pet could be a pet rock, stick or any sort of crafted animal! If students don't have a traditional pet at home they can participate by being creative and using their imagination in the CRAFT pet. Students should not bring borrowed pets. Please choose the 'craft pet' category instead.

We also have the ANIMAL cake raffle. This is the chance for families to bake and decorate an animal themed cake and submit it for a \$2 raffle at the end of the day.

CATEGORY (#)

The animals will be judged on the following, but judges will also question the child on the care of their pet eg. gender, breed, who feeds it, what does it eat/how often and any other special requirements.

RING 1 - Horses and Ponies (All Year Levels)

RULES

- During the day, all animals must be in a cage or suitable container, or secure on a lead at all times. Horses are to be tied to floats.
- Cats and dogs need to have up-to-date vaccinations. Young puppies and kittens that are not fully vaccinated are not able to attend and large dogs must be accompanied by an adult at all times. When not being judged, we ask that dogs be left tied up in their designated area, and **not taken to the small pets area and have a container available for water.**
- **Lambs, Calves and Goats must have been born after 1 June 2022 and please bring a lead or rope to secure your animal.**
- Please ensure that you remove any animal droppings left by your pet (please bring your own bags/buckets for this purpose).
- Calves may be washed and groomed. Lambs are not to be washed or brushed.

SCHEDULE

The programme for the day will be as follows:

10:30am-	Pets can arrive onsite (no pets before this please)
10:50-11:10am-	Morning tea
11:10am-	Ring 1, 2 and 3- Judging commences Novelty Category Junior Novelty Category Senior
1:10pm-	Grand parade in Ring 4 followed by drawing of the cake raffles.
1:15pm -	Picnic lunch, plus sausage sizzle available. Pets leave.

BBQ Sausages will be on sale, but you are welcome to bring your own picnic, chairs, rugs etc.
Don't forget to bring money for the cake auction.

There is no postponement or cancellation day.

Pet Day Entry - No pre-entry required, however we will send out a Google form closer to the time to give us an indication of numbers for judging.

Please also note that we do not want ANY animals arriving at school before 10:30am.
Please ensure you listen to the announcements for class times throughout the day.
