Uniform/Dress

Students are expected to take pride in their uniform and wear it as required. It is worn at school, when travelling to and from school, and at school events as appropriate. All uniform items must be clearly named.

Details of the uniform are on our **school website** \square .

Students are also expected and encouraged to take pride in their general appearance and conform to the following guidelines.

- Hair should be clean, and tied back if it is longer than collar length.
- The only items of jewellery permitted are sleepers or plain studs (one per ear), a watch, a culturally significant item such as a taonga worn around the neck.
- Nose piercings must be discreet, small, plain silver or gold studs. Other body piercings must be free of jewellery during the school day.
- Make-up and nail polish are not to be worn at school.
- Male students must be clean shaven.
